

## **"Woman, Get a Revelation!"**

Transition to Transformation will first and foremost require "revelation".

Revelation: Who you are---Who does God say you are? —  
We MUST first and foremost get a revelation of who God is in our lives. Our ONLY secure place is in the revelation that you are a DAUGHTER of the MOST High God!

Who are you? Woman, GET a revelation!

### **Jeremiah 1:4-5**

Before we can even begin the to Transition to the next place of Transformation, we must first get a revelation. David saw himself as a Shepherd boy, God called him to be a King. Mary saw herself as a woman in love with Joseph, God said she would bear HIS son. Gideon saw himself as the weakest and least, but God called him a MIGHTY MAN OF VALOR! Beloved woman of God...GET a revelation! You have been called, chosen and anointed!

### **Isaiah 61:1-3**

The revelation of who you are now should not AND CANNOT interfere with who God says you are! Get your self aligned with HIS word...not your measly false humility!

1. Get a revelation - quit moping, quit griping, quit whining...don't get mad, GET GLAD! Stop saying, WHY ME LORD...OH...WHY ME? START SHOUTING: Here I am Lord...SEND ME!

Women without revelation remain futile in their thinking, negative in their reactions and hesitant in times of change. They have no hope, no joy or vision. BUT, when a woman of God GETS the revelation of WHO she is in Christ... she is a woman who will persevere through hardships, run to engage in battle, reach for new challenges and carry her cross willingly. Her only goal is to honor her KING and to continually lay her rights down to see HIS will made perfect!

Revelation ignites passion

Passion ignites progress

Progress ignites prosperity

Prosperity ignites purity

Purity ignites power

Power ignites purpose

Purpose fulfills the perfect will of God and causes your destiny to be called to fruition!

When you get the revelation that you can do NOTHING, but HE can do EVERYTHING...no matter how hard, the circumstances, the lack of finances, the unreconciled differences, the wayward child, the addicted spouse, the angry employer...YOU can KNOW that HE is on the THRONE and that NOTHING can hinder what HE will accomplish in you and through you!

Paul said in Philippians: ***"For I know that this will turn out for my deliverance through your prayer and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ, according to my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but with all boldness as always, so now also Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death, For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain"!***

### **1 Samuel 16:6-13**

David had not yet gotten the revelation, even though God was SAYING WHO He was, not only to David, but also to those around him. It was evident to the Father, but not even the prophet Samuel who was sent to anoint him, knew what God has placed upon David. Samuel was looking at the stout brother of David, but God had already poured HIMSELF into David and God knew this man's heart and how that heart would serve Him.

Once you get a revelation, God will start to spiritually upgrade you into a time of transition. You see, NOW YOU KNOW who you are supposed to be, and the excitement and advancement of how to move into that realm is the next phase.

What about a prophetic word? We all want to HEAR BIG words over our lives. Sometimes it is just a means of tickling our flesh, but IF this is the word of the Lord, should we not just pet our ego, should we not take seriously what next steps WE must take in order for us to ALIGN with who God says we are? Are you willing? Or do you just want another word and another word...WOMAN, GET A REVELATION.... God does not have to continually repeat himself to you if you are listening the first time! He will call you to order and tell you what HE says HE is going to do, now AGREE with Him and allow transition to take place in your heart, mind, will and life!

### **1 Samuel 17:12-14**

David was still in the mode of Shepherd boy...but it was NOW time for the revelation....

### **1 Samuel 17:20-26**

SEE where David got the revelation? He SPIRITUALLY UPGRADED when he CAUGHT THE revelation of WHO God WAS IN HIS LIFE!

He started transition when he asked, "What shall be done be done for the man who kills this Philistine and takes away the reproach from Israel? For who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the LIVING GOD?" Did you hear it? He weighed tending sheep to war! He started to get the revelation that GOD, the one who he talked to every morning and night while attending his sheep was NOW being defied by a Philistine Champion. Here David begins the transition from shepherd to warrior.

WHO are you woman of God? Who has GOD said you are? Has he called you to be silent and wait, or has he instructed your tongue to praise Him, worship Him, intercede for others, and prophesy in His name. Do you have your revelation? GOOD, because once you get the revelation, you can now begin the journey of transition!

Transition will always, always, always require FAITH. The Faith to believe that God is WHO HE said He is...that He will do EVERYTHING that He has promised, that He will instruct you in the way that you should go, that no weapon formed against you can prosper, that the righteous will inherit the earth....

Faith to say to Him, Whatever and however, your promises are YES AND AMEN for me!  
Faith that will not allow fear to undertow the current of God's spirit at work in your life  
Faith to wrap up your buckled ankles and broken ribs and continue to move forward with momentum!

A buckled ankle is fear of what man will say or thinks, it is intimidation and anxiety  
Broken ribs are constrictions from our old way of thinking and the tightening of the religious mindsets and rules we once lived under

Once faith is rooted and establish, then we can enter into the next phase of Transition which is CONFRONTATION!

YES...Transition REQUIRES confrontation for our character reconstruction! Confrontational warfare is building GRACE into our lives. It is relying upon the WARRIOR KING of Judah instead of the wimpy lion who only roars but does not know his authority! Confrontation must take place so that we grow INTO the woman of God that HE has called us to be. Confrontation begins the process of the transition TO transformation!

When David got his revelation, he then began his transition. IMMEDIATELY following his step of faith into transition, CONFRONTATION FOLLOWED!

### **1 Samuel 17:28-31**

David's response: "What have I done?" Notice he did NOT cry and pout, turn away and decide he should NOT have asked. AND notice where the confrontation FIRST came from...his own household! Remind yourself at this point that he was NOT even a BIT defeated. He just found out WHO His God was in him.... there was NO stopping him.

David turned from one confrontational episode and stepped back into faith and continued in his transition as he grabbed onto the next challenge again pursued a question that had to be answered. He KNEW that HIS God was SO much bigger than a loud voice from across the valley that was really a wimp at heart!

The second confrontation came: **1 Samuel 17:32-33**

Hear the voice of the enemy speaking to intimidate him? The words that were spoken to David were: "You are not able"... Well, David KNEW that he was not able, but he was FOR CERTAIN THAT HIS GOD IN HIM WAS! He already started to walk in the confidence of his spiritual upgrade! His was transitioning from shepherd to Philistine triumph!

Transition will always require confrontation. Confrontation cements what you believe and uproots what would hold you back. It eliminates your security in yourself, and places it fully upon the ONE in YOU who has CALLED you and GIVEN you YOUR identity!

Confrontation is a crucial time in transition. YOU MUST always remain in a place of being able to ask yourself these questions under extreme pressure:

- 1) Do I love God enough to allow Him to fulfill His purposes in me no matter how much it hurts and how much it costs?
- 2) Do I love other people enough to serve and help them no matter how much I want to defend my rights or be right?
- 3) Am I afraid of not being recognized or proven right? Is there still pride abounding instead of the grace that is building my character?

Confrontation allows God to take the knife and cut away all that is in us that does NOT belong and takes our legs and causes us to STAND in confidence!

### **1 Samuel 17:34-40**

Following this second confrontation, David reminded Saul who HE was. He was not just a young shepherd boy, who led sheep by the still waters, but he was a warrior who struck down bears and wiped out lions, and an uncircumcised giant was nothing more than that! He KNEW His identity. Notice as well, in transition, people will try to cause you to “wear” the same garment that they own. YOU MUST wear the garment HE has given you in your OWN anointing! YOUR identity is like NO OTHER PERSON! David could not wear the armor of Saul for battle because David had his OWN identity, and it was not in the mantle or shadow of someone else’s anointing or ministry. NO WAY! David went out to defeat the enemy because he knew who was GOING in front of him...the King of Kings!

Confrontation will always prove character and establish identity. This time of transition is SO important for us to learn. What if David decided that he was NOT able to go, that His God was NOT big enough, that he really should go back to the fields to sing to the lambs.... when would transition begin for him...when would the prophetic word of him becoming King come to fruition in his life?

Confrontation will show us where our character flaws are, but it will also prove the spiritual DNA that God gave us before we were born to go through the confrontation that takes us into transition!!!!!!!!!!!! He gave us the DNA to go through! SO GO!

In times of war, we will see a side of God we have never experienced before. That is why confrontation and warfare are so important during this phase of our spiritual upgrade. We must remember that our Father is not afraid of anything or anyone. He is not worried that your name is being slandered or your reputation is being discredited. He is not holding his breath wondering what next tactic the enemy may take. He is a God of war and He laughs in the face of the enemy because God knows whom HE IS IN HIMSELF! He has total knowledge of WHO HE IS!

### **1 Samuel 17:41-47**

Cursing from the enemy, taunting and accusations did not shake David. He did not stand any longer in an unknown identity, crying after each word that was tossed in his direction. He KNEW who HIS God was and who HE was in HIS God!

Remember this: Transition without confrontation is only a mere “makeover”.

The final purpose of transition is to build in us the character we are going to need to live in a new level of power and anointing!

As we are being readied through the transitional confrontation, God is at work transforming us into His likeness, with His heart, ALL for HIS glory!

### **2 Timothy 1:8-12**

Transformation begins when we steadfastly proclaim truth where we once believed a lie. It is where the fruits of the spirit are beginning to grow. Yes, in poor soil is where the fruit must take a deeper root. Peace begins to override upset and worry, jealousy dies and withers, condemnation and criticism are replaced with love and joy. Transformation is a process that makes our countenance glow with HIS glory! We become ark carriers! We start to be charged with anticipation instead of down trodden in despair and to be transformed means "a complete and total change"!

Stop trying to find short cuts in the spirit. Stop trying to exhibit power when there is not purity. Stop trying to manufacture hope when you won't give God your future. Quit trying to control your tongue when you have not yet learned to take every thought captive to the obedience of Christ!!!!!!!!!! Go to the cross and die daily! Let the transformation begin—Death to self and LIFE in Christ! Surrender and let the transforming power of Jesus Christ remove the flaws, but allow the spirit of God to express HIS personal identity through you! Stop apologizing for your circumstances---Start prophesying INTO THEM!

You will find that power comes out of suffering and anointing comes out of intimacy. Transformation requires communion with God, fellowship---one on one time! His beloved, his heir, his friend!

(Acts 3-4)

This is the account of the lame man at the gate Beautiful that Peter spoke to. He told him that he would not give any money, but he could give him LIFE. SO, he spoke life to the man's legs and he walked and leaped and praised God!

Peter got a revelation. Peter thought he was only a fisherman. Jesus called him out and said, "you are Peter and upon this Rock I will build my church".... Peter then transitioned into his identity and started to cast out demons, lay hands on the sick, preach the good news...AFTER Christ left this earth.

Now in transition, confrontation made it's way to Peter when he was asked, "by what power or what name have you done this?"

### **Acts 4:8-12**

Peter stood against all confrontation, in HIS identity and then came the transformation.

### **Acts 4:13**

No schooling nor training, nor scientific theories or formulas caused transformation in these men...NO...their transformation was SEEN and evidenced and could NOT be denied...

**They had been with Jesus!**

Women of God get a revelation of your identity.... allow God to transition you and bring you to total transformation. Get with Jesus!
